"I take what interests me in the movies and put it in a shorter format so I don't get bored. What interests the American public are sex and violence and the seamy side of life. Most people don't have those in their lives, so they go looking for them.

"In my film Fingered, the sex is antierotic. If someone gets aroused by it, they have really serious problems. I show the confusion and frustration in sexual relationships: what you have to put up with to have sex. Which is the only thingexcept money and drugs worth living for. In every bigbudget movie there's a love scene, handled in a way that makes you want to puke. Ours are nonpukeable and more realistic."
